Mabley Cottage is tucked away in High Street, a quiet and tranquil setting and area of conservation located only a few minutes walk from the vibrant quayside, shops, cafes and restaurants that picturesque Padstow offers.





This utterly cosy abode has a ground floor comprising an inviting sitting room focused around the wood burning stove with a cute window seat for watching the world go by. The intimate dining room has a beautiful feature fireplace with log burner, ceiling beams and space for a dining room table and chairs. The kitchen, located to the rear of the cottage, is compact but perfectly formed and equipped. The ground floor is complete with a smart modern shower room and separate cloakroom.

Two double bedrooms can be found on the first floor. The master bedroom to the front has not one but two window seats providing a pleasant place to enjoy the view across the rooftops to St Petroc's Church. There is also a feature fireplace. The second bedroom, also a double, is located to the rear.

From the kitchen, is a stable door leading up to a private walled garden complete with slate patio and a raised bed. There is ample space for outdoor furniture within this suntrap garden!

Mabley Cottage has a handsome traditional stone façade in keeping with the local vernacular of Old Town Padstow and one would recommend an appointment to view at your earliest convenience. The historic and picturesque fishing town of Padstow is located on the North Coast of Cornwall

and offers an extensive range of cafés, public houses and restaurants, none more so than Paul Ainsworth's Michelin starred No.6, cool seafood bar Prawn On The Lawn and of course Rick Stein's esteemed Seafood restaurant. An area of outstanding natural beauty, there are an abundance of sandy beaches within 2 to 4 miles as well as the championship golf course at Trevose. The town also has a supermarket and excellent Primary School. For more extensive shopping facilities, the thriving market town of Wadebridge is just 7 miles distant and offers a fine selection of shops and amenities including a sports centre, cinema, a primary and secondary school and a selection of supermarkets. The nearest mainline station is Bodmin Parkway which is approximately 20 miles distant with the nearest airport at Newquay approximately 14 miles away.

To find Mabley Cottage, drive towards Padstow on the A389. Follow the road round the outskirts of the town passing the fire station and main carpark. Turn right at signs for Prideaux Place and Fentonluna. Pass the entrance to Prideaux Place then take the next left into Tregirls Lane.
